所学内容：

今天的课程是关于客西马尼园的（马可福音 14:32-42）。您的孩子学习到：耶稣顺服天父的旨意，甚至顺服到死。如果我们想要像耶稣一样，就必须顺服神的旨意，并按照祂的命令来行事。（经文：马可福音 14:32-42）



牢记神的话语：

要凭爱心行事，效法基督。 -以弗所书 5:2

在这一周里，与孩子一起多背几遍这节经文。这将帮助他/她记住这节经文，并加强他/她在课堂上所学到的。



亲子活动：

问问孩子，当他/她听到“顺服”这个词时，会想到什么。顺服并不总是容易的，但顺服神永远是正确的。有些人我们可以顺服，有些人我们不应该顺服，但我们总可以跟随并顺服耶稣。和孩子一起讨论：哪些人是他/她应该顺服的，哪些人是不应该顺服的。



每日祷告：

亲爱的主，祢创造了我们，也知道什么对我们是最好的，我们愿意顺服祢。求祢帮助我们按祢的命令行事。我们愿意活出一个充满爱的生命，效法耶稣的榜样。阿们。

To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.

What We Learned:



Today's lesson was about the garden of Gethsemane (Mark 14:32-42). Your child learned that Jesus was obedient to His Father's Will, even through death, and if we want to be just like Jesus, we must be obedient to the Will of God and behave according to His commands. (Scripture used: Mark 14:32-42)

Words to Remember:



Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. -Ephesians 5:2a NLT

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child remember the verse and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.

Suggested Parent/Child Activity:



Ask your child what he or she thinks of when he or she hears the word obedient. Being obedient is not always easy, but being obedient to God is always the right thing to do. Some people we can obey, others we should not, but we can always follow and obey Jesus. Discuss with your child people he or she can obey, and those he or she should not obey.

Daily Prayer:



Dear Lord, You created us and know what is best for us, and we want to be obedient to You. Help us behave according to Your commands. We want to live a life of love, following the example of Jesus. Amen.
