写给父母：

所学内容：

今天，通过关于先知以利亚的课程，您的孩子学习到，当他们顺从神的话语时，神会以神奇的方式来供应他的子民。(使用的经文。王上17:1-6)



牢记神的话语：

祂赐粮食给敬畏祂的人；祂永远纪念祂的约。-诗111:5

这一周里跟孩子要多练习这节经文。这不仅会帮助孩子记住这节经文，也会帮助他/她巩固课堂里所学的内容。



建议的亲子活动：

晚餐时，讨论神借着许多神迹给我们每天的供应，使我们能够拥有这么多好吃的。讨论为什么要为神的供应感谢神，不仅是食物，还有天气、住所、健康、智慧、家庭和朋友。神为我们提供的东西不胜枚举。继续解释说，顺服神是我们荣耀神的一种方式，表明我们对神所供应的一切都心存感谢。
