父亲节-去做!

写给父母:

这张反馈单让您知悉您的孩子今天在主日学所学的内容。包含“牢记神的话语”，一个建议的活动来巩固课程内容，还有一个简短的祷告。参与以上内容，并和孩子交流，对您和孩子都会非常有益。



所学内容:

今天，您的孩子学习了“葡萄园主人和两个儿子的比喻”。这个比喻教导孩子做一个有行动的人。说正确的话、拥有好的态度固然很好，但更重要的是，要把这些话付诸行动。我们需要去做神话语中教导我们的事。当父母要求我们做某件事时，我们需要用爱和顺服来回应，并且真正地把他们交代的事完成。（使用经文：箴言6:9-11，箴言10:4-5，马太福音21:28-30。）



牢记神的话语:

你们若爱我，就必遵守我的命令。我要求父，父就另外赐给你们一位保惠师，叫他永远与你们同在。 -约翰福音 14:15-16

这一周内和孩子一起多背几次这节经文。这将帮助他/她记住这节经文，同时也巩固他/她在课堂上学到的知识。和孩子讨论这节经文的意义。



建议的亲子活动:

和孩子谈谈怎样成为一个有行动的人。准备一张纸，在顶部写上“行动记录表”。帮助孩子写下今年在教会或主日学中学到的三件事，然后和孩子一起讨论，这一周怎样把这些教导落实到每天的生活中。例如，如果孩子学到了“感恩”，那么他（她）每天早晨祷告时，可以先感谢神三件事情，而不仅仅是向神提出请求。把这张“行动记录表”贴在孩子房间里或者家中显眼的位置。每当孩子把某一项教导实践出来，并愿意和你分享时，就给他/她贴上一张小贴纸作为鼓励。每天花一点时间，问问孩子今天有没有实践所学的内容，并鼓励孩子与你分享和讨论。



每天的祷告:

亲爱的神，祢是一位伟大的神！感谢祢赐给我父母，也感谢祢赐给我敬虔的老师来教导我。感谢祢赐给我们圣经，使我们每天都能阅读，学习新的功课，帮助我们越来越像祢的儿子耶稣。求祢帮助我，愿意去做父母吩咐我的事。我不愿只是听见祢的话，我更愿意照着祢的话去行，让我的生活一天一天被改变。我要为祢而活。奉耶稣的名祷告，阿们。

To parents:

This page lets you know what your child learned today in Sunday School. Included are "Words to Remember" from the Bible, a suggested activity to reinforce the lesson, and a short prayer. Being involved and interacting with your child can be very rewarding for both of you.



What We Learned:

Today, your child learned the "Parable of the Vineyard Owner and His Two Sons." This parable taught your child to be a person of action. It is awesome to say the right things and have a good attitude when given directions, but the important thing is to act upon those directions. We need to go and do the things we learn in God's Word. We need show our love and obedience when our parents ask us to do something and then follow through by doing what they ask of us. (Scriptures used: Proverbs 6:9-11, Proverbs 10:4-5, Matthew 21:28-30.)



Words to Remember:

"If you love me, keep my commands. And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate to help you and be with you forever." John 14:15-16 NIV

Practice this verse several times with your child during the week. This will help your child remember the verse, and it will help to reinforce what he or she learned during class.



Suggested Parent/Child Activity:

Talk to your child about being a child of action. Take a sheet of paper and write "Action Paper" at the top. Help your child list three things on a sheet of paper that he or she learned about at church or in Sunday school this year. Talk with your child about how he or she can follow through with these teachings in his or her everyday life this week. For example, if your child learned about being thankful, your child could pray each morning and thank God for at least three things instead of just asking God for things. Put this "Action Paper" some place very visible in your child's room or living space. Place stickers by the lesson learned anytime they act out that teaching and talk to you about it. Check in on a daily basis, ask if your child has applied any of the teachings and encourage discussion.



Daily Prayer:

Dear God, You are a great God! Thank You for the parents and godly teachers that You have placed in my life. Thank You for the Bible, that we can read and learn new things every day to help us become more like Your Son Jesus. Please help me to go and do the things my parents ask of me. I don't want to just hear Your Word, I want to act on it and change how I live each day. I want to live for You. In Jesus' name, I pray all these things, Amen.
